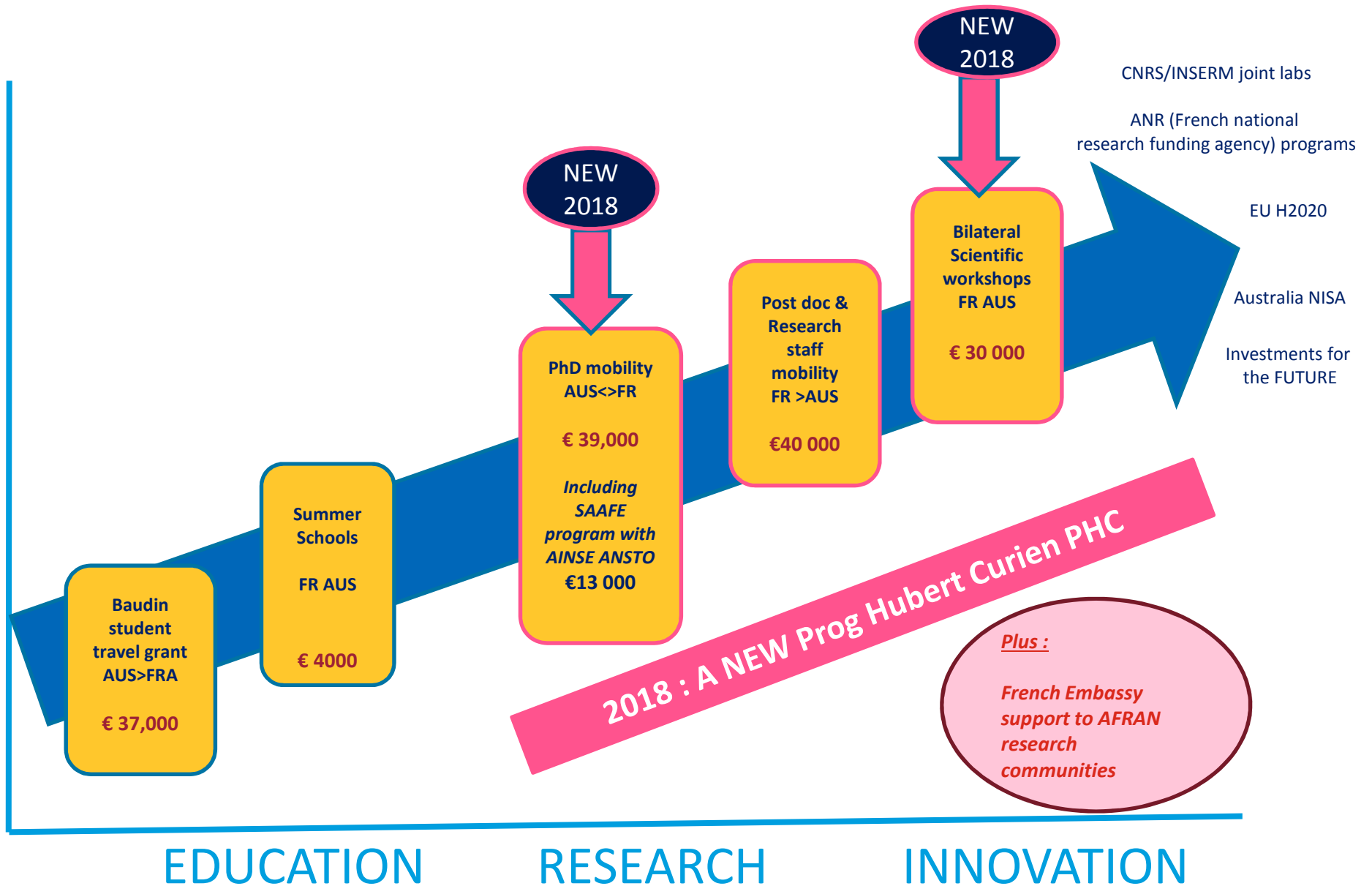

Embassy of France in Australia programs

2017: a €150,000 (AUD234,000) investment
for student and researcher mobility

SEED FUNDING



Focus on student mobility programs (1)

Nicolas BAUDIN Travel Grant

Main program

- Supports travel expenses from Australia to France + social insurance
- Open to B & M students, all disciplines
- Priority for research driven mobility and industry placements
- 10 grants awarded in 2017

Co-funding scheme for the Internship in France Student Mobility Program



- “Hybrid” lab/company internship offers proposed by French universities; stays in France co-funded by French Embassy, French host institution and Australian home institutions
- Objective: create “pipelines” for the next cotutelle / CIFRE PhD candidates...
- 9 grants awarded in 2017

Focus on student mobility programs (2)

Creative France Short programs (summer schools)



- Support for short programs jointly set up by French and Australian universities
- Up to € 4000 (AU\$6200) for one project
- Objective: encourage mobility / reinforce collaborations
- First pilot to be launched in 2017, followed by a call for projects in 2018
- ... can be held in winter

3 streams for the new PHC programme (pilot)



1- Bilateral mobility of PhD students

2- Post-doc and researchers mobility

3- Bilateral scientific workshops on areas of interest for the S&T cooperation

Research : a new Hubert-Curien Program (2)

2018 : Rebranding of the PHC FASIC



STREAM 1 - Bilateral mobility of PhD students

- Embassy funds travel grants to support mobility of AUS PhD students to France or FR PhD students to Australia
- Involved Institutions / research labs commit to provide additional cash /in kind support to the student during the mobility period (accommodation, stipend...)

STREAM 2 - Support to post-doc and researchers mobility

- Embassy funds travel grants to support mobility of post doc and research staff from France to Australia in the context of a starting bilateral research and innovation project
- Expected matching fund is expected from the partnering Australian institution to facilitate reciprocity of mobility from Australia to France

3- Support to bilateral scientific workshops on areas of interest for the cooperation

Research : a new Hubert-Curien Program (3)

2018 : Rebranding of the PHC FASIC



STREAM 3 - Bilateral scientific workshops on areas of interest for the cooperation

- Embassy funds a limited number of bilateral workshops (up to 5 per year) on research areas of strategic relevance for the future of the cooperation
- Scientific workshops are held in Australia
- Embassy funding is given to the French coordinator and aims to primarily support mobility of French researchers to Australia in the context of the workshop
- **Expected impact of the workshop on the S&T bilateral cooperation agenda is key**
- Consequent matching funding from partnering Australian institutions stands as a major eligibility criteria
- Average financial Embassy support per project can be estimated along 6 000 euros
